PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR  
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

THIS MATTER came before this Court upon the Motion for Temporary Restraining  
Order of Plaintiff John Doe 2, as an individual and on behalf of others similarly situated.

Having considered Plaintiff's motion and all pleadings submitted in support of and in  
opposition to the motion, as well as the arguments of counsel for the defendant King County  
(*not appearing*) and Donna Zink (*not* appearing by phone), the Court FINDS:

1) Plaintiff and the proposed class have a clear legal and equitable right to *temporarily* enjoin the  
release of the registration forms to the general public, as the disclosure would cause immediate

1 and irreparable harm and would not be in the public interest. Plaintiff and the proposed class  
2 have shown a likelihood of prevailing on the merits of their claims.

3 2) Plaintiff and the proposed class have a well-grounded fear of immediate invasion of  
4 their rights. Plaintiff and the proposed class's ability to seek injunctive relief would be  
5 meaningless if the forms were released prior to a determination on the merits.

6 3) Plaintiff and the proposed class have shown the anticipated release would result in  
7 substantial and irreparable injury.

8  
9 The Court therefore ORDERS that a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED. It is  
10 ORDERED that King County is enjoined from disclosing any and all sex offender registration  
11 forms for Level II and Level III sex offenders <sup>after the provisions set in RCW 4.24.050</sup>. The Court further ORDERS that King County is  
12 enjoined from releasing any database of information containing information from the  
13 registration forms that is not otherwise available to the public. The Court further ORDERS that  
14 King County shall not release any psychosexual evaluations to Ms. Zink during the pendency of  
15 this Order. This temporary restraining order remains effective until the Court rules on Plaintiffs'  
16 motion for Preliminary Injunction.

17  
18 It is further ordered that there shall be no bond.

19 It is further ORDERED that the parties shall attend the preliminary injunction hearing  
20 scheduled for ~~December~~ <sup>January 20</sup> \_\_, 2014, at <sup>8:30</sup> a.m. before Judge Holly R. Hill in courtroom 7.
